MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 21-094

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$429,076 FOR THE BOROUGH FISH PASSAGE 2025 GRANT, REVISION NO. 1, TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT FISH PASSAGE CULVERT REPLACEMENTS; AND USE MATCHING FUNDS OF \$ 122,980 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 FISH PASSAGE PROJECT; AND \$117,020 FROM THE GRANT MATCH FOR FISH PASSAGE PROJECTS FISCAL YEAR 2021.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 21-184.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby appropriates the amount of \$429,076 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) to fund 410, project no. 30114 and authorizes the use of matching funds in the amount of \$240,000 from fund 410, project no. 30114, for the Borough's 2025 fish passage project for the design and construction of fish passage culvert replacements for Hidden Hills Road at Caswell Creek, O'Brien Creek at Royal Lane, Rubacaba Street, O'Grady Drive, and Settler's Bay Road at Crocker Creek; and Mastadon Road at Birch Creek Tributary.

Section 3. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
