A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE ANTICIPATED PROJECT INCOME DURING FISCAL YEAR 2022 FOR THE RAIL EXTENSION FROM PORT MACKENZIE TO THE MAINLINE ADDING PAYMENT OF WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR AN AFTER-HOURS INITIAL RESPONDER TO EMERGENCIES OCCURRING AT THE PORT MacKENZIE RAIL EXTENSION RENTAL PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, the intent and rational for this resolution can be found in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 21-195.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly approves the following amended scope of work:

AMENDED SCOPE OF WORK

The income from the properties acquired as right of way for the Rail Extension Project from Port MacKenzie to the Mainline will be used for project-related activities including right-of-way acquisition, engineering and environmental work during construction, construction of the rail embankment, bridges, drainage and access structures, providing project management, facilitating public information and involvement activities for the project, the purchase of heating fuel, general maintenance and/or operations items, utilities, replacement or repairs, and wages and benefits for an after-hours initial responder to emergencies occurring at the properties acquired.
