SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough has received an offer for the purchase of a timber sale as illustrated in the enclosed Yoder Road Timber Sale Map. The Yoder Road Timber Sale was offered by competitive sealed bid after complying with the required 30-day public notice. No bids were received. Recent Code changes approved by the Assembly occurred after the competitive bid sale closed. Shortly after the code changes were approved, an offer was made on the Yoder Road Timber Sale that met the minimum bid requirement of the sale. Bond Brothers Logging LLC has completed a salvage harvest of bark beetle killed spruce on an abutting private parcel and have indicated they are ready to begin cutting the dead spruce and birch off the subject Borough parcels.

Harvesting within the subject Borough parcels was proposed because of spruce bark beetle infestation. The removal of large diameter spruce and birch will help reduce fire hazard and improve overall forest health. The timber sale contract will require Bond Brothers to harvest and remove the merchantable spruce timber damaged or killed by the bark beetle as well as all birch greater than seven inches diameter at breast height by October 31, 2023. The land in which timber harvesting will occur has been classified General Purpose. The timber sale was offered to reduce fire danger in the neighborhood and improve forest health.

Access to the subject area will need to be developed by the Purchaser. Several roads, including Yoder Road, are nearby, and easements provide legal access to the timber sale. Private property and wetland buffers reduce the area of the timber sale to 48-acres of the 80-acres within the two Borough-owned parcels.

This over-the-counter timber sale is being offered in accordance with MSB 23.20.130(A).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff respectfully recommend Assembly adoption of the Resolution authorizing the Borough Manager to enter into an agreement with Bond Brothers Logging LLC for the Yoder Road Timber Sale (MSB007759).
