SUMMARY STATEMENT: This legislation is coming forward at the request of Assemblymember Tew.

The proposed amendment to the fees would apply to both Central Landfill and the transfer sites. To make things predictable and easy for public use, the new charge is to add a Special Level Pickup Truck Rate of \$10. All material must be contained in a level pickup truck bed. This rate will apply only to household refuse and C&D materials.
