ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 26-060**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$523.73 FROM THE UNITED STATES FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICE AND \$583.74 FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME, PASSED THROUGH THE PALMER SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT FOR A TOTAL OF \$1,107.47.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance are in the accompanying Informational Memorandum No. 26-099, and Resolution Serial No. 26-047.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a noncode ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and Appropriation Source. The Assembly hereby accepts \$523.73 from the United States Fish & Wildlife Service and \$583.74 from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, passed through the Palmer Soil and Water Conservation District for a total of \$1,107.47, and appropriates \$1,107.47 to fund 410, project no. 30114, Caswell Creek/Caswell Lake Streambank Rehabilitation.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
