**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** The scope of the Parking Lot Striping Project approved by the Assembly in FY26 to restripe recreational facility parking areas did not include ice arenas or pools. Additionally, the scope is currently limited to only parking lot striping.

The ice arenas and pools were recently identified as priority projects, as well as the need for additional pavement preservations, specifically crack sealing. Expanding the project scope to allow funds to be used for all recreational facility parking areas and for pavement preservation will enable priority areas to be addressed this summer and cover pavement preservation needs identified by Public Works.
