SUMMARY STATEMENT: This ordinance is sponsored by Assemblymembers Sumner, Fonov, and Bernier to establish the Board for Advisory Review of Kennel Standards ("BARKS") as an advisory board to review and make recommendations regarding kennel licensing and enforcement.

The board will perform a review of borough code related to kennel licensing and enforcement and may also perform a review of administrative policies and procedures of the Animal Care Division related to the execution and enforcement of borough code related to kennel licensing and enforcement. These narrow directives ensure that the board remains focused on the task at hand.

The board chair will deliver a report to the Assembly no later than December 15, 2026, but may deliver the report as soon as the board has completed their tasks. The board will expire on December 15, 2026 as well. However, the ordinance provides that the Assembly may extend the dates by motion, resolution, or ordinance.
