WHEREAS, the intent and rationale are found in the Informational Memorandum No. 26-099 and Ordinance Serial No. 26-060.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the scope of work and budget as follows.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

Removal of debris, placed rock, and other detrimental structures.  
Digging of a trench, placing of coir logs and planting willows.

**BUDGET**

Project no. 30114, United States Fish & Wildlife Service and Alaska Department of Fish and Game, passed through the Palmer Soil and Water Conservation District - Caswell Creek/Caswell Lake Streambank Rehabilitation	\$1,107.47
Project no. 99999, Fiscal Year 2023 Areawide Budget Appropriation - Caswell Creek/Caswell Lake Streambank Rehabilitation, Match	<u>\$583.73</u>
Total	\$1,691.20

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby authorizes the Manager to enter into an agreement with the United States Fish & Wildlife Service and Alaska Department of Fish and Game for the Caswell Creek/Caswell Lake Streambank Rehabilitation project.
