ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 26-077**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOROUGH FISH AND WILDLIFE COMMISSION TO REDUCE THE MEMBERSHIP FROM 8 VOTING MEMBERS TO 7 VOTING MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance is found in the accompanying Information Memorandum Serial No. 26-123.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. MSB 4.75.005 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.75.005 MEMBERSHIP

(A) The commission is composed of [NINE] **eight** members and shall, **as feasible**, consist of the following representatives:

(1) one sports fishing representative;

(2) one hunting representative;

(3) four at-large representatives;

(4) [TWO] **one** borough assembly representative[S]; and

(5) one previous member who is a nonvoting member and does not count for the purposes of a quorum.

(B) All members of the commission shall be residents of the borough.

(C) The commission shall select from its members, on a yearly basis, a chair and vice-chair.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
