**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 26-082**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO DECREASE
THE MARIJUANA SALES TAX LEVY FROM 5% TO 3%.

WHEREAS, the intent and rationale of this ordinance is found
in the accompanying Information Memorandum Serial No. 26-128.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and
permanent nature and shall become a part of the Borough Code.

Section 2. Amendment of section. MSB 3.60.030(A) is hereby
amended to read as follows:

(A) There is levied a tax of [5] 3 percent upon the sales
price of all retail sales of marijuana and marijuana products
within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough. Every retail sale made
within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough, unless explicitly exempted
by this chapter, is presumed to be subject to the tax imposed under
this chapter in any action to enforce the provisions of this
chapter.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance takes effect
October 1, 2026.
